CLASS DETAILS:

We know you have questions about faith, so join us and get them answered! This class is offered to all Senior High students, but is strongly recommended for students in 9th grade. During our time together, we will explore what we believe and why, what it means to be a part of a church community, be given the opportunity to meet new people and hang out together, learn about Jesus, and much more. Students are required to ask a trusted Christian adult to walk alongside them through this process (see “About Mentors”), and SPC membership will be offered to those who complete the class (optional). Cost is \$55 to cover supplies and a new Bible (parents are required to provide lunch during the teaching sessions); registration deadline is Sunday, December 10. ABOUT MENTORS:

Jesus’ disciples were people who were intentionally trained and carefully mentored throughout their ministry. Having Jesus to walk alongside them and train them allowed the disciples to ask the hard questions, grow deeply in their faith, and have accountability. Following in the steps of Jesus, we have designed Confirmation 2018 to be a class that is built around a mentor/student relationship. We want students to have a dedicated, trusted,



Christian adult to walk alongside them throughout the Confirmation process. This adult will need to attend half of the teaching sessions with their student (see Confirmation Schedule) as well as meet with their

student regularly to catch up, debrief, wrestle with faith and life questions, work on a Statement of Faith, and more. **You might ask, “Who could I ask to be my mentor for Confirmation?”** Great question! Mentors can be coaches, teachers, Senior High leaders, neighbors, grandparents, aunts, uncles, etc. (no immediate family members, please). **If you would like assistance in finding a mentor, the deadline to request our help is December 10.**

Mentors need to sign and submit the *Mentor Covenant* on the *Mentor Brochure* as part of the student’s registration.
